

MTC CHAIR URGES STAKEHOLDERS TO HEIGHTEN SAFETY MEASURES AHEAD OF MUTOMBOKO CEREMONY

Mwansabombwe Council Chairperson Terrioh Chungu has called on the Ministry of Health in the District to ensure they put in place necessary safety measures ahead of the Mutomboko Traditional Ceremony slated for 29th July, 2023.

Mr. Chungu says the department has to enhance checks on food handlers to ensure that the food is fit for people's consumption.

He has further called for the expeditious distribution of condoms in all public places so as to reduce the spread of Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STIs).

The Council Chairperson was speaking when he officially opened the second Ordinary Full Council meeting held at Don Bosco Kazembe.

The Council Chairperson on the other hand expressed delight at the implementation of the Constituency Development Fund - CDF in the District and urged Council management to continue on the path of ensuring the delivery of quality service to the people.

And Acting Council Secretary Mathews Mulenga informed the house that the Local Authority will empower all Ward Development Committees-WDCs in all the twelve wards of the District in order to motivate them.

He says the move is meant to help the committee embark on ventures that can help them become self-sustainable.
